- Newcomers Permanent Residents, Convention Refugees, Refugee Claimants with Work Permit or Naturalized Canadian Citizens
- Professional experience from outside Canada as Early Childhood Educators, Preschool Teachers & Primary Teachers, or possess a Bachelors' of Arts Degree in other related fields is an asset but not required
- English proficiency: CLB Level 5+
